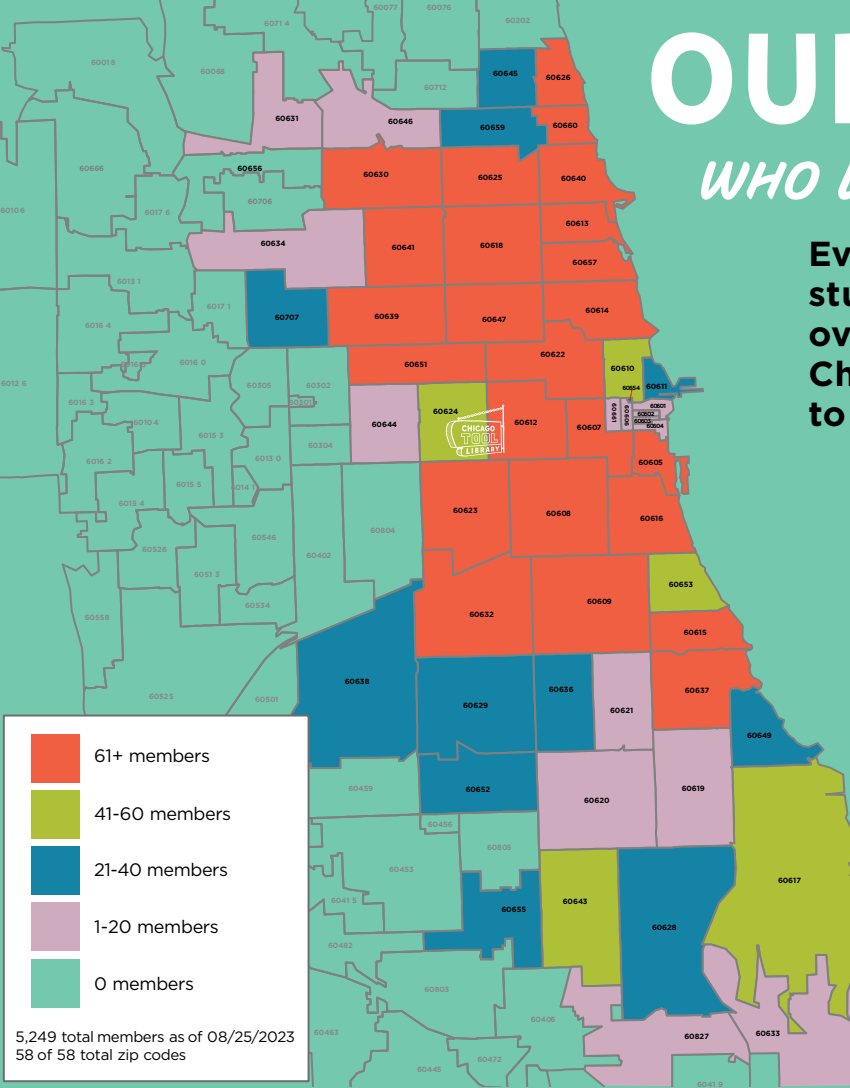
Everyone! From new homeowners, to students, to small business owners, over 5,200 households from all of Chicago's 58 zip codes have signed up to join the tool library.
